**Annual Meeting: May 15, 2025 at 1:30 PM**

Enclosed you’ll find your official ballot, which includes voting for Board of Directors candidates and updates to our Articles of Incorporation and Bylaws.

### How to Vote:

#### 1. Vote In Person at the Annual Membership Meeting

- Attend the Annual Meeting on **May 15th at 1:30 PM**
- Location: **Silver Lining Café, Homer Senior Citizens, Inc., 3935 Svedlund Street, Homer**
- You may cast your completed ballot in person **between 1:00 and 2:00 PM** in the **Silver Lining Café**.

#### 2. Vote In Advance by Drop Box

- Drop off your completed ballot **any time in advance of the annual membership meeting** in the locked **Ballot Drop Box** located in the entry outside the main office at **Homer Senior Citizens, Inc., during regular business hours**.
- Ballots must be dropped off by 11:00 AM on May 15<sup>th</sup>.

#### 3. Vote by Mail

- **Mail your completed ballot to:**

- Ballots must be received by mail no later than the start of the Annual Meeting on May 15, 2025 to be counted.

#### 4. Vote Electronically

- Members attending the Annual Membership Meeting via Zoom may vote electronically during the meeting.
- You will be given a phone number on Zoom to call in your vote at the Annual Meeting. *(Please use this option only if necessary, as there will be just one phone line and one person available to take calls.)*
- Votes must be received and confirmed by 2:00 PM on May 15, 2025 to be counted.
- To attend the Annual Membership Meeting via Zoom, go to [HomerSeniors.org](https://HomerSeniors.org) for the Zoom link on the day of the meeting, or watch your email the morning of the meeting for the Zoom link.

#### 5. Personal Representative Voting (No Excuse Absentee Voting)

- If you are unable to vote in person, by mail, or electronically, you may authorize a **Personal Representative** to vote on your behalf.
- To do this, provide your Personal Representative with a **signed letter stating your name, your intent to vote via representative, and their name**.
- With this letter, your representative may visit the main office to **request a No Excuse Absentee Ballot** and cast your vote for you.
- The completed ballot must still be **received by 2:00 PM on May 15, 2025** to be counted.

### Deadline:

**All ballots must be received no later than 2:00 PM on May 15, 2025** to be counted.
